- All guests must be between 13 and 19 years old at the time of the event.
- Once inside the school, no student may leave the building and reenter. No one will be permitted to go to the car.
- No smoking is permitted inside or outside the school at any time.
- No backpacks, bags, or storage containers other than small purses will be permitted into the prom.
- Purses are subject to search by staff at any time.
